Scholars must hold a terminal degree in their field and may hold any academic rank. The GDFP is open to all academic disciplines.

Greek host institutions can request that the scholar participate in projects in curriculum codevelopment, collaborative research and/or graduate or undergraduate student research mentoring and teaching, for a period between 14 and 90 days.

The deadline to receive both scholar applications and host institution project requests is 30 January 2020 at 11:59 PM Eastern US time (31 January 2020 6:59 AM Greece time.) Selection decisions for Cycle 4 will be made in May 2020; project visits can begin in June 2020.
